- (ii) Sought to be levied upon in an action
  of distress, until levy and any removal[.];
- (7) A petition of injunction filed by a county or municipality including Baltimore City for the enforcement of its health, housing, fire, building, electric, plumbing, and zoning codes[.];
- (8) Proceedings under §§ 264 or 297 of Article 27 for the forfeiture or return of moneys involved in a gambling or controlled dangerous substances seizure where the amount involved, excluding any interest, does not exceed \$5,000[.];
  - (9) A proceeding for adjudication of: [a]
- (I) A municipal infraction as defined in Article 23A, Section 3(b)(1) of the Code; [or a]
- (II) A Commission infraction as defined in Article 66D,  $\S$  5-113 of the Code; OR
- (III) A CIVIL-ZONING-INFRACTION-AS-DEFINED IN ZONING VIOLATION FOR WHICH A CIVIL PENALTY HAS BEEN PROVIDED PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 66B, § 7.01 OF THE CODE; AND
- (10) A proceeding for adjudication of a civil penalty for any violation under Section 8-1411.1 of the Natural Resources Article of the Code or under Section 15B(c-1) of Article 41 of the Code or any rule or regulation issued pursuant to those sections.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

## CHAPTER 799

(House Bill 1760)

AN ACT concerning

St. Mary's County - Treasurer

FOR the purpose of altering the annual salary of the Treasurer of St. Mary's County; repealing the right of the Treasurer to collect certain fees; repealing a provision relating to the salary of the clerk to the Treasurer of St. Mary's County; and providing that this Act does not affect the incumbent Treasurer of St. Mary's County.
