

7-403. GENERAL SURVEY.

(A) DUTY TO SURVEY.

THE BOARD SHALL HAVE ITS REPRESENTATIVES SURVEY:

(1) EACH REGISTERED NURSING AND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM WHEN THE PROGRAM IS FIRST ESTABLISHED IN THIS STATE; AND

(2) FROM TIME TO TIME, EACH EXISTING REGISTERED NURSING AND LICENSED PRACTICAL NURSING PROGRAM IN THIS STATE.

(B) WRITTEN REPORT.

THE REPRESENTATIVES WHO MAKE THE SURVEY SHALL SUBMIT A WRITTEN REPORT TO THE BOARD.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first sentence of Art. 43, § 298(c) and the first two sentences of § 298(d).

In subsection (a)(1) of this section, the reference to a survey when a program is first established is new language added to clarify that the Board may survey both new and existing programs.

7-404. REMOVAL FROM APPROVED LIST.

(A) GROUNDS FOR WITHDRAWAL OF APPROVAL.

THE BOARD MAY REMOVE AN INSTITUTION FROM ITS LIST OF INSTITUTIONS THAT OFFER APPROVED NURSING EDUCATION PROGRAMS IN THIS STATE IF THE INSTITUTION:

(1) VIOLATES THE STANDARDS SET UNDER THIS TITLE OR BY THE BOARD; AND

(2) DOES NOT CORRECT THE VIOLATION IN A REASONABLE TIME AFTER NOTICE IS GIVEN.

(B) NOTICE AND HEARING.

ANY ACTION TAKEN UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HEARING AND ADMINISTRATIVE AND JUDICIAL REVIEW PROVISIONS OF §§ 7-313 AND 7-314 OF THIS TITLE.

Subsection (b) of this section is new language substituted for the present references to notice and a hearing. This substitution conforms with a
