FOR the purpose of authorizing the indemnification of certain public officials of Caroline County who are made parties to legal proceedings by reason of their service as Caroline County public officials.

The Public Local Laws of Caroline County Section 32A Article 6 - Public Local Laws of Maryland (1965 Edition and 1980 Supplement, as amended)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 6 - Caroline County

32A.

IF AN ELECTED OR APPOINTED OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT, OR AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION NOT COVERED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF ARTICLE 78A, § 16C, OR ARTICLE 32A, § 12A OF THE CODE, ACTS WITHIN THE SCOPE OF HIS OFFICIAL DUTIES OR EMPLOYMENT AND WITHOUT MALICE, THE COUNTY MAY INDEMNIFY THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE FOR ANY JUDGMENT, PENALTY, FINE, SETTLEMENT, AND REASONABLE FEES AND EXPENSES INCURRED IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PROCEEDING IN WHICH THE OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE IS MADE A PARTY BY REASON OF SERVICE AS OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
