

In regard to subsection (d) of this section, Standard State Travel Regulations are adopted by the Department of Personnel with the approval of the Board of Public Works.

7-503. CONFIDENTIALITY OF RECORDS.

(A) "CONFIDENTIAL RECORD" DEFINED.

(1) IN THIS SECTION, "CONFIDENTIAL RECORD" MEANS ANY RECORD OF THE BOARD THAT CONCERNS AND IDENTIFIES A LICENSEE, FORMER LICENSEE, OR LICENSE APPLICANT.

(2) "CONFIDENTIAL RECORD" DOES NOT INCLUDE A RECORD:

(I) OF THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF AN EXAMINATION;

(II) OF A LICENSE ISSUANCE OR RENEWAL;

(III) THAT INDICATES THAT AN INDIVIDUAL IS NOT LICENSED OR WAS NOT LICENSED AT A PARTICULAR TIME; OR

(IV) OF A FINAL DECISION OF THE BOARD UNDER §§ 7-312 OR 7-605 OF THIS TITLE.

(B) SCOPE OF CONFIDENTIALITY.

A CONFIDENTIAL RECORD IS EXEMPT FROM:

(1) PROCESS; AND

(2) DISCLOSURE UNDER THE "PUBLIC INFORMATION ACT", ARTICLE 76A, § 1 ET SEQ. OF THE CODE.

(C) ACCESS TO CONFIDENTIAL RECORDS.

A CONFIDENTIAL RECORD IS AVAILABLE TO:

(1) THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OR ITS AUTHORIZED EMPLOYEES;

(2) THE INDIVIDUAL TO WHOM THE RECORD RELATES OR AN AUTHORIZED AGENT OF THAT INDIVIDUAL;

(3) THE PARTIES TO A PROCEEDING HELD UNDER §§ 7-312 OR 7-605 OF THIS TITLE FOR THE PURPOSE OF INSPECTING AND COPYING IT; AND

(4) A COURT FOR JUDICIAL REVIEW OF A DECISION OF THE BOARD IN A PROCEEDING UNDER §§ 7-312 OR 7-605 OF THIS TITLE.

(D) WAIVER OF CONFIDENTIALITY.
