

United States or any bureau or department thereof; provided that except as otherwise provided herein, the above provisions shall not apply in Montgomery County, with the exception of that portion of the City of Takoma Park now situated in Montgomery County or to those portions of the City of Bowie over which the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission had jurisdiction prior to July 1, 1978, with respect to storm and surface water drainage.

3-9. Private contributions toward cost of project.

(A) The commission, or after June 30, 1968 in Montgomery County, except for that portion of the City of Takoma Park now situated in Montgomery County, the county council, or after July 1, 1978, the governing body of the City of Bowie, with respect to those portions of the city which had been under the jurisdiction of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission prior to July 1, 1978, for purposes of storm and surface water drainage control, may require any owner or developer of a subdivision or tract of land upon which dwellings, apartments, stores or other buildings, are to be erected to contribute what it deems to be a fair share of the cost of a drainage project before it approves or constructs such project, such contribution to be paid in cash before construction begins or secured to the satisfaction of the commission; and [said] THE commission may construct any part of any approved drainage project, provided the person or company interested contributes not less than one-half of the cost thereof.

(B) In Montgomery County (except for that portion of the City of Takoma Park situated in Montgomery County) and in the City of Bowie (with respect to those portions of the city which had been under the jurisdiction of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission prior to July 1, 1978 for purposes of storm and surface water drainage control), the respective governing body may construct any part of any approved drainage project if the person or company interested contributes a share of the cost of the project considered appropriate by the governing body. In Montgomery County and the City of Bowie, the directors of the department of public works shall include in their annual submission of estimates of capital projects to the county executive or the mayor, as the case may be, a request for an appropriation of sufficient funds for anticipated contribution to drainage projects.

3-10. Contracts with federal agencies.

The commission shall have the right to contract with the government of the United States or any of its agencies for any gift, advance or loan which, in the opinion of [said] THE commission may be advantageous in the construction of any project under sections [83-85 - 83-92] 3-7 to 3-12.
