- (1) The availability of water from Maryland's ground water given present and future demands;
- (2) The availability of water from Maryland's reservoirs and other surface water sources given present and future demands;
 - (3) The potential for water shortages in Maryland;
- (4) Specific proposals for a State water conservation strategy;
- (5) The establishment of a water conservation strategy for implementation in all State facilities;
- (6) The availability and use of water for residential, commercial, industrial, agricultural and all other legitimate purposes;
- (7) The effectiveness of the water conservation measures as required under Article 43, Section 325D of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and other water conservation measures in use in Maryland; and
- (8) The pricing of water use in Maryland as it relates to water demands; and be it further
