- (4) The feasibility of other anchorages being established elsewhere on the Bay;
- (5) The adequacy of transportation to and from the vessels and the adequacy of securing provisions for the vessels; and
- (6) The adequacy of the services provided for the seamen in the ports of Annapolis and Baltimore; and be it further

RESOLVED, That this study be conducted by the Department of Natural Resources, in coordination with the Departments of Health and Mental Hygiene and Transportation; that these State agencies, in conducting and preparing this study shall consult with the United States Coast Guard, the City of Baltimore, the City of Annapolis, Queen Anne's and Anne Arundel Counties, the Maryland Watermen's Association, the Steamship Trade Association, the Association of Maryland Pilots, and the Maryland Chamber of Commerce; and be it further
