This bill authorizes the creation of a State debt in the amount of \$1,000,000, the proceeds to be used to provide State funds for design and construction of shore erosion control projects.

House Bill 736, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 19, 1981, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 456.

AN ACT concerning

Program Open Space - Allocations for Fiscal Year 1982

FOR the purpose of designating Program Open Space projects to be funded under the Outdoor Recreation Land Loan of 1969 during fiscal year 1982; resolving any possible doubt about the validity and effectiveness of this designation which might arise from a conclusion that it is a contraction of State debt requiring in the same law a provision for collection of an annual tax or taxes to cover principal and interest payments on that debt; and relating generally to the Outdoor Recreation Land Loan of 1969.

BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,
