SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

(a) In this title, the following words have the meanings indicated.

~~(B) -- "CONCESSION" MEANS A RIGHT GRANTED BY THE STATE TO A PERSON TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, OR PROVIDE A RECREATION-RELATED FACILITY OR SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC WITHIN A STATE-OWNED OR LEASED FOREST, PARK, SCENIC PRESERVE, NATURAL AREA, PARKWAY, HISTORIC MONUMENT, OR RECREATION AREA OR NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AREA.~~

(B) "CONCESSION" MEANS A LICENSE OR PERMIT GRANTED BY THE STATE TO A PERSON TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, OR PROVIDE A FACILITY OR SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC WHICH ENHANCES THE RECREATIONAL USE OF THE LAND BY THE PUBLIC BUT WHICH IS NOT INCOMPATIBLE WITH THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH THE LAND WAS ACQUIRED.
