

(1) TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE EXTENT TO WHICH EXISTING SERVICES WITHIN THE IMMEDIATE AREA WILL BE IMPACTED,

(2) HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING IN THE AFFECTED AREA, AND

(3) SUBMIT A REPORT OF DEPARTMENT FINDINGS TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS ALONG WITH THE PROPOSED PLAN AND PROGRAM.

(D) THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE CONCESSIONS MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION TO SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE SECRETARY. THE COMMISSION CONSISTS OF NOT MORE THAN NINE MEMBERS AND SHALL INCLUDE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PLANNING, THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES, AND THE TOURISM INDUSTRY.

(D) THE CONCESSIONS MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION SHALL CONSIST OF A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, A MEMBER OF THE SENATE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, THE SECRETARY OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE PLANNING AND THE SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GENERAL SERVICES. THE SECRETARY SHALL APPOINT THE REMAINING MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION, WHICH SHALL INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE TOURISM INDUSTRY. THE COMMISSION MAY NOT CONSIST OF MORE THAN NINE MEMBERS EXCEPT WHEN THE DEPARTMENT PROPOSES A CONCESSION WITHIN A LOCAL JURISDICTION. A TENTH MEMBER OF THE COMMISSION SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY WHERE THE CONCESSION IS BEING CONSIDERED.

(A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUEST THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY TO REVIEW AND COMMENT ON ANY PLANS FOR CONCESSION DEVELOPMENT WITHIN ITS JURISDICTION BEFORE THE PLAN IS APPROVED.

(B) THERE IS A CONCESSIONS MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION IN THE DEPARTMENT.

(C) THE CONCESSIONS MANAGEMENT ADVISORY COMMISSION SHALL INCLUDE A MEMBER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE, A MEMBER OF THE SENATE APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE, A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE PLANNING, AND A MEMBER APPOINTED BY THE SECRETARY OF GENERAL SERVICES. THE SECRETARY OF NATURAL RESOURCES SHALL APPOINT FOUR OTHER MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION, ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE TOURISM INDUSTRY. WHENEVER THE COMMISSION CONSIDERS A CONCESSION WITHIN A COUNTY OR BALTIMORE CITY, THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY WHERE THE CONCESSION IS BEING CONSIDERED SHALL APPOINT AN ADDITIONAL MEMBER.
