Dear Mr. President:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed Senate Bill 881.

This bill authorizes the creation of a State debt in the amount of \$700,000, the proceeds to be used for a grant to the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore for the renovation, restoration, rehabilitation, repair, alteration and improvement of the Baltimore City Zoo.

House Bill 699, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 19, 1981, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign Senate Bill 881.

Senate Bill No. 882

AN ACT concerning

Creation of a State Debt - Kent County Jail Loan of 1981

for the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt in the amount of \$1,500,000, the proceeds to be used as a grant to Kent County to assist in the alteration, enlargement, extension, expansion, improvement, reconstruction, rehabilitation, renovation, and repair of the Kent County Jail, subject to the requirement that Kent County provide at least an equal and matching amount fund of a certain kind for the same purpose by a certain date; and providing generally for the issue and sale of bonds evidencing the loan.
