Dear Mr. Speaker:

In accordance with Article II, Section 17 of the Maryland Constitution, today I have vetoed House Bill 770.

This bill eliminates the requirement in Baltimore City that tax sale property be posted with a sign before the property is advertised for sale. It also allows the City to collect from the proceeds of a tax sale a fee for the mailing of statements and notices.

Senate Bill 501, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on May 19, 1981, accomplishes the same purpose.

Therefore it is unnecessary for me to sign House Bill 770.
