(D) IN DORCHESTER COUNTY THE HOLDER OF A CLASS A ~~(ON-SALE)~~ (OFF-SALE) BEER LICENSE MAY EMPLOY A PERSON 16 YEARS OLD OR OLDER TO SELL BEER AT THE LICENSEE'S PLACE OF BUSINESS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

This bill was introduced to allow minors in Dorchester County to stock beer. However, because of a conflict between the title of the bill and its body, the bill does not accomplish the original intent of the sponsor and, therefore, at his request, I have vetoed House Bill 1320.
