

FOR the purpose of increasing the expense allowance for orphans' court judges in Anne Arundel County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Estates and Trusts
Section 2-108(c)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1974 Volume and 1980 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article - Estates and Trusts

2-108.

(c) Each of the judges of the court for Anne Arundel County shall receive an annual compensation of \$3,000. The Chief Judge shall receive an additional \$500 annually. Each judge shall also receive an expense allowance up to [\$100] \$150 per month for personal expenses incidental to his duties, to be paid by the comptroller of Anne Arundel County each month upon presentation of an itemized voucher in accordance with rules and regulations prescribed by the comptroller.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
