AN ACT concerning

Anne Arundel County - State's Attorney's Office

FOR the purpose of altering the method of determining the salary of the assistant State's attorneys and the deputy State's attorneys of Anne Arundel County; providing that the number of assistant State's attorneys for Anne Arundel County shall be as determined by the County; providing that the State's Attorney, with the approval of the administrative judge of the Circuit Court for Anne Arundel County, may appoint a temporary State's Attorney with the concurrence of the County; clarifying language; and generally relating to the salaries and numbers of deputy and assistant State's attorneys of Anne Arundel County.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 10 - Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact  
Section 40(c)  
Annotated Code of Maryland

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 10 - Attorneys at Law and Attorneys in Fact

(c) In Anne Arundel County:

(1) The State's Attorney's salary shall be equal to the salary of a circuit judge of the eight judicial circuits. The State's Attorney, during his term of office, may not appear, except in connection with and in performance
