RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, MARYLAND, INTRODUCED AND PASSED PURSUANT TO ITS GENERAL POWERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING AND REVISING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF HAGERSTOWN, A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION, EXISTING UNDER AND BY VIRTUE OF THE LAWS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND AND IN PARTICULAR AMENDING ARTICLE II, SECTION 13, COUNCILMEN; ELECTION, QUALIFICATIONS, SALARY.

RESOLUTION, of the Council of The City of Hagerstown, Maryland, adopted pursuant to Article XI-E, § 4 of the Constitution of the State of Maryland, labeled and entitled "MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS, PROCEDURE FOR ADOPTION, AMENDMENT OR REPEAL OF CHARTERS"; and pursuant to Article 23A of the Annotated Code of the Public General Laws of Maryland, entitled "Corporation - Municipal, Charter Amendments" as said sections were enacted by Chapter 423 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, session of 1955, and subsequent amendment thereto; and to amend the now existing Article II, Registration and Elections, § 13, Councilmen; Election, Qualifications, Salary, of the Corporate Charter of the City of Hagerstown as adopted in 1949, and subsequently amended to conform with the applicable constitutional and statutory provisions of the State of Maryland pertaining thereto.
