- Whereas, the present Charter of Landover Hills was originally enacted by the General Assembly in the Laws of Maryland, 1945, Chapter 465;
- Whereas, this Charter has served the Town of Landover Hills as a basic instrument of government for 35 years;
- Whereas, the needs of the Town require a more modern document to help meet the contingencies of modern life;
- Whereas, this historic document is insufficient in its present form and language to enable the Town to properly carry out its mandated functions;
- Whereas, a new and modern Charter has been proposed by the Landover Hills Council;
