AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE to add new Subtitle 5, "Toxic Chemicals", to Title 11, "Health and Welfare", of the Anne Arundel County Code (1967 Edition and Supplement), to follow immediately after Subtitle 4, "Sanitary Landfills" thereof; to prohibit the storage of the chemical polychlorinated biphenyl with certain exceptions; to provide for the registration of all such chemicals now stored; to prohibit after a certain date the continued storage of said chemicals now stored; to regulate the transportation of said chemicals by requiring a permit therefor; to specify a fee for said permit; to provide remedies for the enforcement of said Subtitle; to provide criminal penalties for the violation of said Subtitle; and generally relating to the regulation of
