AN ACT to increase parking fines in the county, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments, Section 17-72 of Article VI. Parking Fines, Penalties and Procedures, title "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" of the Baltimore County Code, 1978, and Section 17-84 of Article VII. Fire Lanes and Interference with Emergency Equipment of said title and code.

AN ACT to change the minimum right of way width for certain streets, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments, Section 22-39(a), the definition of "Streets" contained in Section 22-53 and the minimum right of way width for "Minor streets" contained in Section 22-86, all of Article IV. Subdivision Control Generally, title "Planning, Zoning and Subdivision Control" of the Baltimore County Code, 1978; and to clarify the right of way requirements contained in Section 30-15, title "Roads, Bridges, Sidewalks and Storm Water Drainage" of said Code, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments, Section 30-15 of said title and code.
