AN ACT proposing to amend Article VI, "Budgetary and Fiscal Procedures," of the Howard County Code by repealing Section 602 thereof, "Definition of Terms Used in This Article;" by repealing Section 603 thereof, titled "Comprehensive Scope of Budget," and reenacting as new Section 602, bearing the same title but with amendments clarifying the definition and scope of the County Budget; by repealing Section 604 thereof, "Submission and Contents of the County Budget," and reenacting with amendments as new Section 603 to require the Executive to submit to the Council the proposed County-budget current expense budget and the operating expense program not later than seventy days before the end of the fiscal year and the proposed
