# Chapter 20

AN EMERGENCY ACT, to amend Section 52-24, title "Certain Transfers Exempt From Tax", of Article II, title "Real Property Transfer Tax", of Chapter 52 title "Taxation" of the Montgomery County Code 1972, as amended, to provide that certain transfers to spouses or former spouses pursuant to the terms of a separation agreement or divorce decree are exempt from the real property transfer tax, and to provide that the Act shall apply retroactively to all properties transferred on or after Janaury 1, 1979.
