Chapter 44

AN EMERGENCY ACT to repeal and reenact with amendments, Section 33-4, title "Salaries of Chairman and Members of Personnel Board," of Chapter 33, title "Personnel," of the Montgomery County Code 1972, as amended, to increase the annual salary of the Chairman of the County Personnel Board to \$6,800 and to increase the annual salary of the members of the Personnel Board to \$6,000; and to provide for future salary increases at a percentage which is 50% of the percentage which the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for the Washington Metropolitan Area for the previous September shall have changed from the September of the previous year.

Chapter 45

AN EMERGENCY ACT to amend Article III, title "Permits" of Chapter 8 of the Montgomery County Code 1972, as amended, title "Buildings", by repealing in its entirety Section 8-29A, title "Moratorium on Alteration or Demolition of Historic Sites"; and to provide that this is emergency legislation and shall take effect on the date on which it becomes law.
