AN ACT ENTITLED A BILL TO REPEAL AND REENACT CERTAIN SECTIONS OF TITLE 14 OF THE TALBOT COUNTY CODE DEALING WITH PERMITS AND FEES FOR PLUMBING WORK, LICENSES REQUIRED, BONDS REQUIRED BY THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT, CHANGING PENALTY PROVISIONS FOR VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE, AND REQUIRING LICENSES FROM THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT FOR TRAILER CAMPS.
