11-404. FALSE DIPLOMA REPRESENTATION.

AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE MAY NOT REPRESENT FALSELY THAT THE APPLICANT HOLDS A DIPLOMA OR DEGREE FROM A COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN OSTEOPATHIC ASSOCIATION.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 479, as that section relates to an applicant falsely representing that the applicant holds a diploma.

The reference to the school being accredited by the American Osteopathic Association is new language added to conform to the education qualifications of § 11-302 of this title.

11-407. PENALTY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT IN JAIL NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR BOTH.

(B) EXCEPTION.

A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THE PROVISIONS OF § 11-403 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$500 OR IMPRISONMENT IN JAIL NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
