13-203. OFFICERS.

(A) ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN.

FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.

(B) MANNER OF ELECTION.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF THE CHAIRMAN SHALL BE AS THE BOARD DETERMINES.
