

(B) MEETINGS.

THE BOARD SHALL DETERMINE THE TIMES AND PLACES OF ITS MEETINGS.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS ENTITLED TO:

(1) COMPENSATION DETERMINED BY THE BOARD AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, UP TO A MAXIMUM OF \$50 FOR EACH DAY THE MEMBER DOES WORK FOR THE BOARD; AND

(2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) STAFF; EXPERTS AND CONSULTANTS.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY:

(1) A STAFF; AND

(2) EXPERTS AND CONSULTANTS TO OBTAIN INFORMATION AND ADVICE THAT RELATE TO PHYSICAL THERAPY.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 606(b), (c), and the fourth sentence of (d) and Art. 43, § 606(f).

Subsection (b) of this section is standard language added to this and, where necessary, corresponding sections of other titles of this article, for clarity.

In subsection (a) of this section, the present provision calling for a quorum to do business of "four members" is restated, without substantive change, in more general language that refers to "a majority of the full authorized membership of the Board". This language conforms to similar provisions in other titles of this article and will accommodate possible future legislative changes in the number of members to be appointed to the Board, without the necessity of enacting a conforming change here. As to the current "full authorized membership" of the Board, see § 13-202(a)(1) of this subtitle.

As to subsection (c) of this section, Standard State Travel Regulations are adopted by the Department of Personnel with the approval of the Board of Public Works.
