13-302. QUALIFICATIONS OF APPLICANTS -- GENERALLY.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(1) TO QUALIFY FOR A PHYSICAL THERAPY LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF:

- (I) THIS SECTION; AND
- (II) § 13-303 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(2) TO QUALIFY FOR A PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT LICENSE, AN APPLICANT SHALL BE AN INDIVIDUAL WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF:

- (I) THIS SECTION; AND
- (II) § 13-304 OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(B) MORAL CHARACTER.

THE APPLICANT SHALL BE OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER.

(C) EXAMINATIONS.

EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS TITLE, THE APPLICANT SHALL PASS THE APPROPRIATE EXAMINATION GIVEN BY THE BOARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

(D) ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS.

THE APPLICANT SHALL MEET ANY OTHER QUALIFICATIONS OR REQUIREMENTS THAT THE BOARD ESTABLISHES FOR LICENSE APPLICANTS.
