13-303. SAME -- PHYSICAL THERAPISTS.

(A) EDUCATED IN ANY STATE.

IF AN APPLICANT FOR A PHYSICAL THERAPY LICENSE HAS BEEN EDUCATED IN PHYSICAL THERAPY IN ANY STATE, THE APPLICANT SHALL HAVE:

(1) GRADUATED FROM A PHYSICAL THERAPY CURRICULUM THAT, IN THE YEAR OF GRADUATION, WAS APPROVED BY:

(I) ~~THE COUNCIL--ON--MEDICAL--EDUCATION--OF~~ THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION; OR

(II) THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION; AND

(2) COMPLETED SATISFACTORILY THE CLINICAL TRAINING REQUIRED BY THE PHYSICAL THERAPY CURRICULUM.

(B) EDUCATED OUTSIDE OF ANY STATE.

IF AN APPLICANT FOR A PHYSICAL THERAPY LICENSE HAS BEEN EDUCATED IN PHYSICAL THERAPY OUTSIDE OF ANY STATE, THE APPLICANT SHALL HAVE:

(1) GRADUATED FROM A PHYSICAL THERAPY CURRICULUM THAT HAS EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS COMPARABLE TO THOSE APPROVED BY:

(I) ~~THE COUNCIL--ON--MEDICAL--EDUCATION--OF~~ THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOCIATION; OR

(II) THE AMERICAN PHYSICAL THERAPY ASSOCIATION; AND

(2) COMPLETED IN ANY STATE A PRECEPTORSHIP THAT FULFILLS THE REQUIREMENTS SET BY THE BOARD.
