

1. AN APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND

2. ANY OTHER DOCUMENT REQUIRED BY THE BOARD; AND

(III) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE APPLICATION FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

(2) IN ADDITION TO THE REQUIREMENTS OF PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION, TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR A TEMPORARY LICENSE AN APPLICANT EDUCATED OUTSIDE OF ANY STATE SHALL HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED FOR A PRECEPTORSHIP.

(B) SCOPE.

(1) A TEMPORARY LICENSE ISSUED TO A PHYSICAL THERAPIST AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PRACTICE PHYSICAL THERAPY WHILE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

(2) A TEMPORARY LICENSE ISSUED TO A PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANT AUTHORIZES THE HOLDER TO PRACTICE LIMITED PHYSICAL THERAPY WHILE THE TEMPORARY LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

(C) TERM.

(1) UNLESS THE BOARD REVOKES A TEMPORARY LICENSE, EACH TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES 60 DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE NEXT SCHEDULED EXAMINATION.

(2) IF A HOLDER OF A TEMPORARY LICENSE APPLIES FOR A LICENSE BY EXAMINATION BUT DOES NOT REPORT TO TAKE THE NEXT SCHEDULED EXAMINATION, THE TEMPORARY LICENSE EXPIRES ON THE DATE OF THAT EXAMINATION.

(D) EXTENSION; RENEWAL.

THE BOARD MAY:

(1) EXTEND A TEMPORARY LICENSE TO COMPLETE A PRECEPTORSHIP; OR

(2) RENEW A TEMPORARY LICENSE ONCE FOR AN ADDITIONAL TERM UNDER SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, IF THE HOLDER:

(I) OTHERWISE MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION;

(II) SUBMITS A RENEWAL APPLICATION TO THE BOARD ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND

(III) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE TEMPORARY LICENSE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

(E) ISSUANCE OF REPLACEMENT LICENSE.
