

(4) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE CONSUMER MEMBERS WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS OF CONSUMER MEMBERS.

EACH CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

(1) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;

(2) MAY NOT BE OR EVER HAVE BEEN A PHYSICIAN OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PHYSICIAN;

(3) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO IS A PHYSICIAN OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PHYSICIAN;

(4) MAY NOT PARTICIPATE OR EVER HAVE PARTICIPATED IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO MEDICINE;

(5) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO PARTICIPATES IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO MEDICINE; AND

(6) MAY NOT HAVE HAD WITHIN 2 YEARS BEFORE APPOINTMENT A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.

(C) SAME -- RESTRICTION.

WHILE A MEMBER OF THE BOARD, A CONSUMER MEMBER MAY NOT HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.

(D) OATH.

BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, EACH APPOINTEE TO THE BOARD SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE 1, § 9 OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

(E) TENURE.

(1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 4 YEARS, EXCEPT THAT THE INITIAL TERM OF ONE OF THE CONSUMER MEMBERS IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 1981.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(F) VACANCIES; PHYSICIAN MEMBER.

(1) IF A VACANCY OCCURS AS TO A PHYSICIAN MEMBER, THE BOARD SHALL SELECT AN INTERIM MEMBER TO SERVE UNTIL THE FACULTY ELECTS A NEW MEMBER TO FILL THE VACANCY.
