- (1) A CERTIFIED PSYCHOLOGIST WHO HAS PRACTICED, TAUGHT, OR ENGAGED IN RESEARCH IN PSYCHOLOGY FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS;
 - (2) A CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES; AND
 - (3) A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE.
 - (C) QUALIFICATIONS OF CONSUMER MEMBER -- IN GENERAL.

THE CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

- (1) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
- (2) MAY NOT BE OR EVER HAVE BEEN A PSYCHOLOGIST OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PSYCHOLOGIST;
- (3) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO IS A PSYCHOLOGIST OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A PSYCHOLOGIST;
- (4) MAY NOT PARTICIPATE OR EVER HAVE PARTICIPATED IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO PSYCHOLOGY;
- (5) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO PARTICIPATES IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO PSYCHOLOGY; AND
- (6) MAY NOT HAVE HAD WITHIN 2 YEARS BEFORE APPOINTMENT A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.
 - (D) SAME -- RESTRICTION.

WHILE A MEMBER OF THE BOARD, A CONSUMER MEMBER MAY NOT HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.

(E) OATH.

BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, EACH APPOINTEE TO THE BOARD SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.

- (F) TENURE; VACANCIES.
 - (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON JULY 1, 1981.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REST OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
