- 16-204. QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION; STAFF.
 - (A) QUORUM.

A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD IS A QUORUM.

- (B) MEETINGS.
- (1) THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.
 - (2) THE BOARD MAY HOLD SPECIAL MEETINGS, IF:
 - (I) REQUESTED BY THE SECRETARY; OR
- (II) THE CHAIRMAN OR A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD CONSIDER A MEETING TO BE NECESSARY OR ADVISABLE.
- (3) REASONABLE NOTICE OF ALL BOARD MEETINGS SHALL BE GIVEN IN THE MANNER DETERMINED BY THE BOARD.
 - (C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.
 - A MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS ENTITLED TO:
- (1) COMPENSATION, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, FOR EACH DAY ON WHICH THE MEMBER IS ENGAGED IN PERFORMING THE DUTIES OF THE MEMBER'S OFFICE; AND
- (2) REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.
 - (D) STAFF.
 - (1) THE BOARD MAY APPOINT A BOARD SECRETARY.
- (2) THE BOARD SECRETARY MAY BE COMPENSATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
- (3) THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY OTHER STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
 - REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 623 and from the first through sixth sentences of § 624 -- except for the reference in the first sentence of that section to the annual election of officers, which now appears in § 16-203(a) of this subtitle.
