

As to subsection (c) of this section, Standard State Travel Regulations are adopted by the Department of Personnel with the approval of the Board of Public Works.

16-205. IMMUNITY FROM CIVIL LIABILITY.

A MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS NOT CIVILLY LIABLE FOR ANY ACT PERFORMED IN GOOD FAITH AND WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE DUTIES OF THE BOARD.

16-206. MISCELLANEOUS POWERS AND DUTIES.

(A) POWER TO ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS.

IN ADDITION TO THE POWERS SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS TITLE, THE BOARD MAY ADOPT RULES AND REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

(B) DUTIES.

IN ADDITION TO THE DUTIES SET FORTH ELSEWHERE IN THIS TITLE, THE BOARD SHALL:

(1) SUBMIT AN ANNUAL REPORT OF ITS ACTIVITIES TO THE SECRETARY AS SOON AS PRACTICABLE AFTER THE END OF EACH FISCAL YEAR; AND

(2) ADOPT AN OFFICIAL SEAL.

16-207. ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES; DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

(A) ESTABLISHMENT OF FEES.

(1) EXCEPT FOR THE FEES SPECIFICALLY SET BY THIS TITLE, THE BOARD SHALL SET REASONABLE FEES FOR THE ISSUANCE AND RENEWAL OF CERTIFICATES AND ITS OTHER SERVICES.

(2) THE FEES CHARGED SHALL BE SET SO AS TO PRODUCE REVENUES THAT APPROXIMATE THE COST OF MAINTAINING THE BOARD.

(B) DISPOSITION OF FUNDS.

THE BOARD SHALL PAY ALL FUNDS COLLECTED UNDER THIS TITLE INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THIS STATE.
