

(C) RECIPROCITY.

AN AGREEMENT MAY BE MADE WITH ANOTHER STATE UNDER THIS SECTION ONLY IF, UNDER THE AGREEMENT, THE OTHER STATE WAIVES THE EXAMINATION OF REGISTERED SANITARIANS OR SANITARIANS IN TRAINING OF THIS STATE TO A SIMILAR EXTENT AS THIS STATE WAIVES THE EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS FOR INDIVIDUALS CERTIFIED IN THAT STATE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new and more specific language derived from Art. 43, § 734, which reads in full "§ t § he Board may enter into agreements for reciprocity with any state possessing laws which are equivalent to the provisions of this subtitle." Its revision is patterned after the standard language used throughout this article for provisions that allow making reciprocal agreements for the waiver of examination requirements.

17-308. ISSUANCE, CONTENTS, AND REPLACEMENT OF CERTIFICATE.

(A) ISSUANCE.

THE BOARD SHALL CERTIFY AND ISSUE THE APPROPRIATE CERTIFICATE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS TITLE.

(B) CONTENTS.

THE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE ON EACH CERTIFICATE THAT IT ISSUES:

- (1) THE DESIGNATION "REGISTERED SANITARIAN" OR "SANITARIAN IN TRAINING";
- (2) THE NAME OF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER;
- (3) THE DATE OF ISSUE AND SERIAL NUMBER OF THE CERTIFICATE;
- (4) THE BOARD SEAL; AND
- (5) THE SIGNATURE OF THE BOARD.

(C) REPLACEMENT OF LOST, DESTROYED, OR MUTILATED CERTIFICATE.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A NEW CERTIFICATE TO REPLACE A LOST, DESTROYED, OR MUTILATED CERTIFICATE IF THE CERTIFICATE HOLDER PAYS A FEE OF NOT MORE THAN \$25 THAT IS SET BY THE BOARD.
