2-203. OFFICERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.

(B) ELECTIONS.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE AS THE BOARD DETERMINES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 801(f).

Subsection (b) of this section is standard language added to clarify the manner of election for officers of the Board.

In subsection (a) of this section, the phrase "from among its members" is added for clarity, in accordance with the current practice of the Board.

2-204. QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION; STAFF.

(A) QUORUM.

A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD IS A QUORUM TO DO BUSINESS.

(B) MEETINGS.

THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.
