

18-203. OFFICERS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN AND A SECRETARY.

(B) ELECTIONS AND TERMS OF OFFICE.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS AND THEIR TERMS OF OFFICE SHALL BE AS THE BOARD DETERMINES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 862(f).

Subsection (b) of this section is standard language added to clarify the manner of election for officers of the Board and their terms of office.

In subsection (a) of this section, the phrase "from among its members" is added for clarity, in accordance with the current practice of the Board.

Also in subsection (a) of this section, the reference to a "secretary" is added to conform with the express mention of this office in the second sentences of present Art. 43, §§ 863(f) and 868(b).

18-204. QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION; STAFF.

(A) QUORUM.

A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD IS A QUORUM TO DO BUSINESS.

(B) MEETINGS.

THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.

(C) COMPENSATION.

EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

(D) STAFF.

THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
