18-502. TERMINATION OF TITLE.

SUBJECT TO THE EVALUATION AND REESTABLISHMENT PROVISIONS OF THE REGULATORY PROGRAMS EVALUATION ACT OF 1978, THIS TITLE AND ALL RULES AND REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE SHALL TERMINATE AND BE OF NO EFFECT AFTER JULY 1, 1984.

TITLE 19. SPEECH PATHOLOGISTS.

SUBTITLE 1. DEFINITIONS; GENERAL PROVISIONS.

19-101. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

The present phrase "unless the context otherwise requires" is deleted as unnecessary.

(B) BOARD.

"BOARD" MEANS THE STATE BOARD OF EXAMINERS FOR SPEECH PATHOLOGISTS.

The word "State" is added to the name of the Board to achieve uniformity among the names of the health occupation boards that this article governs.
