AND CHIRURGICAL FACULTY OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND. THERE SHALL BE AT LEAST THREE NAMES ON THE LIST.

- (4) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE AUDIOLOGIST AND SPEECH PATHOLOGIST MEMBERS, WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY, FROM A LIST SUBMITTED TO THE SECRETARY BY THE MARYLAND SPEECH AND HEARING ASSOCIATION. THE NUMBER OF NAMES ON THE LIST SHALL BE AT LEAST THREE TIMES THE NUMBER OF VACANCIES.
- (5) THE GOVERNOR SHALL APPOINT THE CONSUMER MEMBER WITH THE ADVICE OF THE SECRETARY AND THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE.
 - (B) QUALIFICATIONS OF ALL MEMBERS.

EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

- (1) SHALL BE A RESIDENT OF THIS STATE; BUT
- (2) MAY NOT BE AN EMPLOYEE OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- (C) QUALIFICATIONS OF CONSUMER MEMBER -- IN GENERAL.

THE CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD:

- (1) SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC;
- (2) MAY NOT BE OR EVER HAVE BEEN A SPEECH PATHOLOGIST OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A SPEECH PATHOLOGIST;
- (3) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO IS A SPEECH PATHOLOGIST OR IN TRAINING TO BECOME A SPEECH PATHOLOGIST:
- (4) MAY NOT PARTICIPATE OR EVER HAVE PARTICIPATED IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO SPEECH PATHOLOGY;
- (5) MAY NOT HAVE A HOUSEHOLD MEMBER WHO PARTICIPATES IN A COMMERCIAL OR PROFESSIONAL FIELD RELATED TO SPEECH PATHOLOGY; AND
- (6) MAY NOT HAVE HAD WITHIN 2 YEARS BEFORE APPOINTMENT A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.
 - (D) SAME -- RESTRICTION.

WHILE A MEMBER OF THE BOARD, A CONSUMER MEMBER MAY NOT HAVE A SUBSTANTIAL FINANCIAL INTEREST IN A PERSON REGULATED BY THE BOARD.

(E) OATH.

BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, EACH APPOINTEE TO THE BOARD SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION.
