

(B) ELECTIONS.

THE MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS SHALL BE AS THE BOARD DETERMINES.

REVISOR'S NOTE: Subsection (a) of this section is new language derived without substantive change from Art. 43, § 801(f).

Subsection (b) of this section is standard language added to clarify the manner of election for officers of the Board.

In subsection (a) of this section, the phrase "~~§ f §~~ from among its members" is added for clarity, in accordance with the current practice of the Board.

19-204. QUORUM; MEETINGS; COMPENSATION; STAFF.

(A) QUORUM.

A MAJORITY OF THE FULL AUTHORIZED MEMBERSHIP OF THE BOARD IS A QUORUM TO DO BUSINESS.

(B) MEETINGS.

THE BOARD SHALL MEET AT LEAST ONCE A YEAR, AT THE TIMES AND PLACES THAT IT DETERMINES.

(C) COMPENSATION AND REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES.

A IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET, EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD IS ENTITLED TO:

(1) MAY---NOT---RECEIVE---COMPENSATION,---BUT COMPENSATION, AT A RATE DETERMINED BY THE BOARD, FOR EACH DAY ON WHICH THE MEMBER IS ENGAGED IN THE DUTIES OF THE MEMBER'S OFFICE; AND

(2) IS-ENTITLED-TO--REIMBURSEMENT REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED-IN-THE-STATE-BUDGET- REGULATIONS.

(D) STAFF.

THE BOARD MAY EMPLOY A STAFF IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE BUDGET.
