UNLESS AUTHORIZED BY THE BOARD, THE CONSUMER MEMBER OF THE BOARD MAY NOT PARTICIPATE IN ANY ACTIVITY RELATED TO EXAMINATIONS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the last three sentences of Art. 43, § 793 (a)(4) and from Art. 43, §§ 794 and 803 (b)(6).

Subsection (a) of this section is standard language added to this and, where necessary, corresponding sections of other titles of this article, as discussed in the General Revisor's Note to this article.

Subsection (d) of this section, which is derived from Art. 43, § 794(a), is revised in the standard language used for comparable notice of examination provisions in other titles of this article.

In subsection (e) of this section, the references to the Board determining the "form" and "passing scores" for examinations administered under this section are added for clarity and to conform to similar references throughout this article.

As to subsection (f) of this section, the present language, which allows an applicant to be reexamined after failing an examination, is rephrased to clarify that the Board may not limit the number of times an applicant may take an examination.

In subsection (g) of this section, the word "authorized" is substituted for "approved", for clarity.

The reference in present Art. 43, § 794(a) to the power of the Board to designate examiners is deleted as unnecessary in light of the broad provisions of this section.

19-305. WAIVER OF REQUIREMENTS.

(A) GENERAL REQUIREMENTS.

THE BOARD MAY WAIVE ANY OF THE QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR A LICENSE UNDER THIS TITLE FOR AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

- IS OF GOOD MORAL CHARACTER;
- (2) PAYS THE APPLICATION FEE REQUIRED BY THE BOARD UNDER § 19-303 OF THIS SUBTITLE; AND
