from one state to another before moving to Maryland to practice here.

19-306. ISSUANCE OF LICENSE.

THE BOARD SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO:

- (1) MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS TITLE; AND
- (2) PAYS THE LICENSE FEE SET BY THE BOARD.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section is new language derived without substantive change from the first sentence and -- as it applies to speech pathologists -- the second sentence of Art. 43, § 795(a).

The provisions of present Art. 43, § 795(a) that relate to audiologists now appear in Title 2 of this article. See the General Revisor's Note to this title.

19-307. SCOPE OF LICENSE.

A LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE LICENSEE TO PRACTICE SPEECH PATHOLOGY WHILE THE LICENSE IS EFFECTIVE.

19-308. TERM AND RENEWAL OF LICENSES.

(A) TERM OF LICENSE.

A--bigenge--expires--on--the--first--anniversary-of-its except as provided for a limited license in § 19-310 of this subtitle, a license expires on the May 31 after its effective date, unless the license is renewed for a 1-year term as provided in this section.

(B) RENEWAL NOTICE.

AT LEAST 1 MONTH BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE BOARD SHALL SEND TO THE LICENSEE, BY FIRST CLASS MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS GIVEN TO THE BOARD BY THE LICENSEE, A RENEWAL NOTICE THAT STATES:

- (1) THE DATE ON WHICH THE CURRENT LICENSE EXPIRES;
- (2) THE DATE BY WHICH THE RENEWAL APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE BOARD FOR THE RENEWAL TO BE ISSUED AND MAILED BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES; AND
