

(3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.

(C) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE:

(1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;

(2) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD; AND

(3) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD:

(I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND

(II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT SET UNDER THIS SECTION FOR LICENSE RENEWAL.

(D) CONTINUING EDUCATION.

IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD, BY RULE OR REGULATION, SHALL ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AS A CONDITION TO THE RENEWAL OF LICENSES UNDER THIS SECTION.

(E) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OF EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(F) GRACE PERIOD.

A SPEECH PATHOLOGIST HAS A GRACE PERIOD OF 30 DAYS AFTER THE SPEECH PATHOLOGIST'S LICENSE EXPIRES IN WHICH TO RENEW IT RETROACTIVELY, IF THE SPEECH PATHOLOGIST:

(1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO HAVE THE LICENSE RENEWED; AND

(2) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE RENEWAL FEE AND ANY LATE FEE SET BY THE BOARD.
