- (3) THE AMOUNT OF THE RENEWAL FEE.
- (C) APPLICATIONS FOR RENEWAL.

BEFORE THE LICENSE EXPIRES, THE LICENSEE PERIODICALLY MAY RENEW IT FOR AN ADDITIONAL 1-YEAR TERM, IF THE LICENSEE:

- (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO BE LICENSED;
- (2) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE RENEWAL FEE SET BY THE BOARD; AND
 - (3) SUBMITS TO THE BOARD:
- (I) A RENEWAL APPLICATION ON THE FORM THAT THE BOARD REQUIRES; AND
- (II) SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF COMPLIANCE WITH ANY CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT SET UNDER THIS SECTION FOR LICENSE RENEWAL.
 - (D) CONTINUING EDUCATION.
- IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD, THE BOARD, BY RULE OR REGULATION, SHALL ESTABLISH CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS AS A CONDITION TO THE RENEWAL OF LICENSES UNDER THIS SECTION.
 - (E) ISSUANCE OF RENEWAL.

THE BOARD SHALL RENEW THE LICENSE OF EACH LICENSEE WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION.

(F) GRACE PERIOD.

A SPEECH PATHOLOGIST HAS A GRACE PERIOD OF 30 DAYS AFTER THE SPEECH PATHOLOGIST'S LICENSE EXPIRES IN WHICH TO RENEW IT RETROACTIVELY, IF THE SPEECH PATHOLOGIST:

- (1) OTHERWISE IS ENTITLED TO HAVE THE LICENSE RENEWED; AND
- (2) PAYS TO THE BOARD THE RENEWAL FEE AND ANY LATE FEE SET BY THE BOARD.
