19-313. DENIALS, REPRIMANDS, SUSPENSIONS, AND REVOCATIONS -- GROUNDS AVAILABLE.

SUBJECT TO THE HEARING PROVISIONS OF § 19-314 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE BOARD MAY DENY A LICENSE OR LIMITED LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT, REPRIMAND ANY LICENSEE OR HOLDER OF A LIMITED LICENSE, OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE OR LIMITED LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT, LICENSEE, OR HOLDER:

- (1) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY OBTAINS OR ATTEMPTS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE OR LIMITED LICENSE FOR THE APPLICANT, LICENSEE, OR HOLDER OR FOR ANOTHER;
- (2) FRAUDULENTLY OR DECEPTIVELY USES A LICENSE OR LIMITED LICENSE;
- (3) COMMITS FRAUD OR DECEIT IN THE PRACTICE OF SPEECH PATHOLOGY;
- (4) IS CONVICTED OF A CRIME INVOLVING MORAL TURPITUDE:
- (5) OBTAINS A FEE THROUGH FRAUD OR MISREPRESENTATION;
