CHAPTER 34

(House Bill 58)

AN ACT concerning

Garrett County - Alcoholic Beverages - Retail Delivery

FOR the purpose of authorizing retail deliveries of alcoholic beverages to a purchaser in Garrett County provided the retail dealer is licensed to sell and distribute alcoholic beverages in the county; and clarifying language.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages
Section 115(b)
Annotated Code of Maryland
(1976 Replacement Volume and 1980 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That section(s) of the Annotated Code of Maryland be repealed, amended, or enacted to read as follows:

Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages

(b) In Queen Anne's, Kent, [and] Talbot, AND GARRETT counties, however, there shall be no retail delivery to a purchaser of any alcoholic beverages unless the retail dealer is authorized to sell and distribute alcoholic beverages in Queen Anne's, Kent, [and] Talbot, OR GARRETT counties by a license issued by the clerk of the court of [Queen Anne's, Kent and Talbot counties] THE RESPECTIVE COUNTY.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
