For the purposes of this article unless otherwise required by the context:

- (c) (1) "Light wine" means any naturally fermented wine containing not in excess of 14 percent of alcohol by volume.
- (5) IN KENT COUNTY, LIGHT WINE MEANS ANY FERMENTED BEVERAGE NOT IN EXCESS OF 22 PERCENT OF ALCOHOL BY VOLUME.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.
