- (2) In Baltimore, CARROLL, and Harford counties, a person may not use, sell, possess, set, place, or maintain a snare trap.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

- (a) (1) The county commissioners of each county in this State, in addition to, but not in substitution of, the powers which have been or may be granted them, have the following express powers.
- (1) (1) To provide for competitive bidding for any county work and the making and awarding of contracts for the
