purchase of materials and supplies in excess of \$500 and to require bonds in connection with the work or contracts, whenever deemed proper; and if no bids are submitted in response to any calls therefor, to place the order as in their discretion they deem best.

- (2) (i) The contracts shall be in excess of the amounts specified for the counties set forth in this paragraph.

  - (iii) Carroll County--\$3,500
  - (iv) Charles County--\$2,500
  - (v) Frederick County--\$3,500

  - (ix) Talbot County--\$1,000
  - (x) Worcester County--\$2,500

## CHAPTER 54

(House Bill 979)
