

(B) In addition to its own power to adopt appropriate rules and regulations, the board may adopt and enforce regulations of the state department of health and mental hygiene or the Frederick County Health Officer, or both, fixing standards of construction for water and sewer facilities or installations.

(C) Prior to the adoption of any such rules and regulations other than those of the state department of health and mental hygiene or the Frederick County Health Officer, the board shall [given] GIVE public notice of the rules and regulations which it proposes to adopt by publishing A FAIR SUMMARY OF the same in at least one newspaper of general circulation published in Frederick County at least twice not less than fifteen (15) days prior to a public hearing, the date, time and place of which shall be specified in the notice.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1981.

#### CHAPTER 63

(House Bill 1151)

AN ACT concerning

#### Frederick County - Benefit Assessments

FOR the purpose of authorizing the tax sale of certain property, which has been benefited by the construction of roads in Frederick County and which is subject to benefit assessments, in the event of nonpayment of the benefit assessments due.
