2. [be] BE provided with an automobile for so long as they shall remain appointed assistant sheriff, for the use and work of the office of Sheriff, with adequate maintenance and insurance of the automobile to be at the expense of the county[,]; and

3. [be] BE provided with an expense allowance of not more than \$1,000 annually, an accounting of which shall be submitted to the County Director of Finance for approval.

(III) The assistant sheriffs shall devote their full time and attention to the office of Sheriff.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect ~~January 1, 1983~~ July 1, 1981.
